Enrollment in May: 3768 up 21 students since September.

2023/2024 Budget was approved by the board. This will be sent to Alberta Education. This will be available to the website as prior years.

4 year Ed Plan- approved by board. This will be sent to Alberta Ed, and made available in print and on our site. There will also be communication from the division to stakeholders with a "what we heard" document sent.

Increase to bus contractors of 5%. We always give back to our contractors. We do not hold or carry over any funds. In past years we have done a wait and see approach in this making approvals for increases at the end of the year to be fiscally responsible. However, after doing this for some years, the Division is confident that we can support an increase to begin Sept 1, and not have to "wait" to deliver any extra funds we may have available at the end of the year. The board is happy that the division took diligence to work through this process, so that now we are able to support our contractors especially with the rising costs of fuel, insurance and maintenance, and need for more contractors.

Irma Daycare- made a request to the board to place self containing modulars on the Irma school grounds. This was approved by the board. The division will allow a space-placement to be determined, for the daycare and sees this as a positive asset to the Irma school and community.

Secretary Treasurer Peter Neale- appointed as new effective May 2023. Welcome him to the team, and all the best to him and his family as they set up their home in Wainwright.

Accepted the Superintendent resignation. Work is underway for the hiring of a new Superintendent for the Division. The board has hired a consultant with ASAB that will work with the board to hire.
